Each project is specific to one or more of the age categories.

The following Projects are supported by the Texas Conference and provide a safe, organized avenue for your church mission teams. Your church can organize a team or send individuals with other churches on any of the projects listed. Teams consist of 6-25 people. International teams require a minimum of 10 people.

Funding from the Texas Conference matches the project supply fee which is calculated into the individual's price of the mission. Construction experience is an added benefit; however, most volunteers are trained on location. There is always something for everyone. Most projects will accommodate VBS along with the construction team.
