The following projects are supported by the Texas Annual Conference and provide a safe, organized avenue for all mission teams. Your church can organize a team or send individuals with other churches on any of the projects listed. **Adult only teams.**

Funding from the Texas Conference matches the project supply fee which is calculated into the individual's price of the mission. Medical professionals are necessary, but non-medical volunteers are very important for the running of the clinics. VBS can also be conducted during the clinic hours for those in the waiting room. Most Medical teams are for Adults only, but other requests can be made of Team Leaders.
