1 gallon size Zip bag	2 granola bars
1 toothbrush	1-2 packages of raisins or dried fruit
1 small tube of toothpaste	1-2 packages of Tuna with crackers
1 bottle of water	1 wash cloth

Travel size—soap, shampoo and rinse

Flood Buckets

Each family should have one bucket for themselves and one to Give Away!

- 5-gallon bucket with reseal able lid
- Bleach (two 1-quart or one 82 oz. bottle).
- 5 scouring pads
- 1 scrub brush
- 18 cleaning towels (easy-wipes)
- 7 sponges
- Liquid laundry detergent (two 25 oz. or one 50 oz. bottle)
- 1 household cleaner, 12-16 oz. bottle
- Disinfectant dish soap, 16-28 oz. bottle
- 50 clothes pins
- Clothes line (two 50 ft. or one 100 ft.)
- 5 dust masks
- 2 pair latex gloves
- 1 pair work gloves
- 24-bag roll heavy-duty trash bags, 33-45 gallon (remove from box)
- 1 insect repellent spray, 6-14 oz. can
- 1 air freshener, 8 or 9 oz. can

All bottles should be plastic. Send new, un-opened items inside bucket and seal the lid. Do not include bleach if shipping.

School Pack Program

These packs are distributed among needy families on the border of South Texas and Mexico.

- Pack of (10) pencils
- 2 Ball point pens
- 1-8 oz. bottle of school glue
- 5-Single subject spiral notebooks
- Pack of (12) colored pencils
- 1 calculator
- 1 ruler
- 1 eraser
- 1 pencil sharpener (plastic)
- 1 Back pack

Sewing Kits

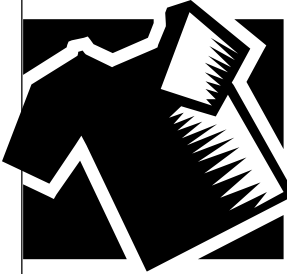

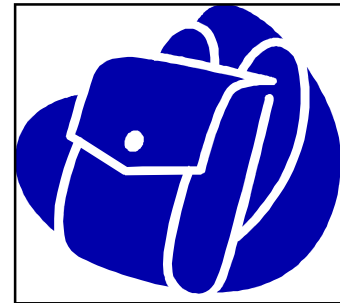
Sewing Projects

The following projects are requested around the world for people in need. Some will go with UMCOR and some with our mission teams. Patterns available through our Sewing Ministry. Call the PIM office for more information 713-521-9383.



Baby gown or shirt— Simple gowns for newborns which become shirts when only half the pattern is used. Colorful remnants can be used and the sewing is very easy. Ties in the back so no snaps or buttons. These are sent out by UMCOR to disaster areas.

Child's School Bag— This very simple pattern is used not only for our own Mission projects in Mexico to help children with school preparation, but are sent all over the world. The pattern is very basic and can be sewn in just minutes.



P.E.T.'s Adult Bag— This larger tote bag is needed by the physically challenged who have been given the PET cart for transportation. The large tote helps them carry supplies while they ride in their new vehicle. Again the pattern is very simple. Some heavy duty materials are available through the Sewing Ministry.
